Any student with previous study in Theology needs to apply in writing to the senate of the Bible Institute for credit. The senate holds the right whether or not to grant credit for previous Theological studies. Credit for previous studies will ONLY be awarded once the student has completed and passed successfully the Theological studies towards the Certificate in Christian Ministries. The credit will be in the form of an Advanced Certificate in Christian Ministries.

CERTIFICATE IN CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES & DIPLOMA IN CHRISTIAN MINISTRY (Dip. CM) 1st, 2nd, and 3rd YEAR PLUS PROGRAM (80 credit hours and 150 credit hours)

ADVANCED DIPLOMA IN CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES. 200 Credit Hours

Once a student has successfully graduated and completed the Diploma in Christian Ministry, students then move on to the advanced Diploma in Christian Ministry. After completion of all the final subjects and exams, students' needs to hand in a 25-35 page thesis as per instructions and guidelines in fulfillment and as per the academic prospectus. Presented to the faculty of the Graduate school of the International Pentecostal Bible Institute in South Africa.

BACHELORS IN THEOLOGY (B.Th.) 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th YEAR PLUS PROGRAM 300 Credit Hours

Students holding an advanced Diploma in Christian Ministries need to apply in writing to the senate for completion of the Bachelor's Degree in Theology. After permission has been granted and all final subjects and exams completion, students' need to hand in a 40-55 page thesis as per instructions and guidelines in fulfillment and as per the academic prospectus. The thesis needs to be presented to the faculty of the Graduate school of the International Pentecostal Bible Institute in South Africa.

DISTANCE STUDIES

Distance studies have become an integral part of our post-Secondary school system. Distance study is ideal for those whom cannot attend full time study or whom could not complete full time study due to other obligations and are thus not deprived of the opportunity of obtaining tertiary education. Distance learning is for both the professional student and the lay. Students are given the opportunity to study from home and be involved in a local church.

We strongly encourage all our correspondence students to inform their local pastors/ministers of their studies and to be actively involved in the life of their local church. No classes are attended; you work at your own pace in your own time at home.

All courses are offered through the distance study program. Study material may be delivered by post or email and students may choose to have study material emailed as well as submit assignment's through the mail or deliver personally to the faculty.

All assignment's worksheets etc. must be submitted neatly written on A4 paper or in the Microsoft Word format. For students in other provinces or whom live to far from the campus, a invigilator, a pastor, minister, or educator, may be commended, whom then needs to apply and be registered with the Institute to act as an invigilator. No friends or family are allowed to invigilate.

All exams can be collected by the invigilators or it will be posted or emailed to invigilators and needs to be returned to the Institute within 72 hours. Students can write their exams at the Campus of the International Pentecostal Bible Institute in Brits with prior arrangement during the exam period October/November

Students completing the advanced diploma and Bachelors in Theology are required to hand in the final thesis as per the guidelines of the senate. Students will be provided will all regulations and guidelines well in advance regarding procedures and format of the dissertations/thesis. All thesis needs to be typed and handed in at the end of September each academic year for appraisal.

POLICIES, PROCEDURES AND PRACTISES

Graduation requirements - Certificates, Diplomas and degrees. A pass rate of 50% for exams is necessary. A Pass rate of 60% for assignments and dissertations and thesis's.

FINANCIAL POLICIES

1. Registration

All prospective students must register with The Bible Institute to attend any of the courses offered. The following documentation is required:

- 1. Completed and signed registration documents.
- 2. A copy of the students Identification document (ID).
- 3. A Nonrefundable Registration fee

The total cost per academic year - R2 600.00

All fees are payable at the date of registration to complete registration. Registration cost includes all exam fees and exam registration for the year.

The student is required to purchase his/her own Study material, textbooks and stationary. Textbooks are purchased separately from all other school costs. Postage fee is payable for the distance learning program.

OUTSTANDING ACADEMIC FEES

Graduation will be denied to those who have any outstanding fees for the academic year.

LANGUAGE POLICY

Accordingly English is also the language of study material, qualification certificates and Academic transcripts. Students registering to study with the institute needs to be fully literate and conversant in English.

To be ordained as minister of religion, Student Pastors must have completed and passed the Certificate in Christian Ministry course successfully and prove that they are in ministry as an pastor, cell group leader, evangelist or have pastored a church for at least 12 Months.
